- FP7 medium-scale focused research projects
- funded under the same call
- similar budgets
- similar time period (3 years from fall 2008)
- very similar objectives
- different consortia and methodologies

Different ways of coexistence

1) Competition

- do the same things as fast as possible and get half of the work published
- complement each other by chance

2) Collaboration

- do the same things together (join forces on common studies)
- and/or: make sure to do different things (avoid overlap, complement each other)

encouraged by EC, recommended by coordinators, agreed by majority of partners

Overall goal should be to maximize useful scientific results
